Each year a total of 4 wananga are held; 3 learning wananga and 1 grading wananga in Term 4. All taira are required to attend Mau rākau wānanga from start to finish. Please see remaining wānanga dates for 2020 below;

Wananga 3: 30th October (Mock grading) – Kia Aroha

Wananga 4: 13th November (Grading) – Te Raki Paewhenua

Mau rākau requires commitment both at kura and home in order for taira to achieve by gaining Pou and NCEA credits under the Mau rākau curriculum.

After the mock grading each taira is given feedback to enhance their skills and in preparation for the grading wananga at the end of the year.

Parents are strongly encouraged to attend all Wananga Mau rākau from beginning to end especially grading wananga. This will give parents a better insight into the kaupapa of Te Whare Tu Taua and the Mau rākau curriculum
